
Dear Applicant:

Enclosed is your application for a Captive Wildlife Permit.

The fee for a Captive Wildlife Permit was set at \$32.00. Please review the attached regulations and the question and answer sheet to ensure you are familiar with the requirements for this permit. If you are applying for this permit to hold captive cervids (fallow deer, elk and their relatives), you do not need a Captive Wildlife Permit, but you must contact the Nebraska Department of Agriculture and apply for a Captive Cervidae Permit.

ATTENTION DOG TRAINERS: Under the new legislation, you do not need a Captive Wildlife permit to hold birds for noncommercial dog training purposes. Please refer to the enclosed question and answer sheet for information on the new dog training regulations.
