



2017 Platte Deer Management Unit



MANAGEMENT UNIT DESCRIPTION - Those parts of Arthur, Custer, Dawson, Deuel, Frontier, Garden, Keith, Lincoln, Logan, McPherson and Perkins counties south of Nebraska Highway 92, west of Nebraska highways 40 and 47, north of Nebraska Highway 23, and east of a line starting at the junction of Nebraska highways 27 and 92, then south on Nebraska Highway 27 to U.S. Highway 30, then west on U.S. Highway 30 to U.S. Highway 385, then south on U.S. Highway 385 to the Nebraska-Colorado state line.

NOTES -

- Mule deer are not allowed on Platte Whitetail permits.
- Lincoln County Refuge: sections 21, 26, 27, 28, 34, 35, 36 T14N, R30W in Lincoln County within 110 yards of the banks of the North Platte River are open to deer hunting. Landowner permission is required.
- No person shall have more than one Platte Unit permit that allows the take of a mule deer buck.
- Platte MDCA permits are valid during the Nov. 12-20 firearm season with all legal weapons and during the Dec. 1-31 muzzleloader season with a muzzleloader.
- Garden County Refuge: Those portions of Garden County within 110 yards of the banks of the North Platte River are closed to deer hunting, except the entire refuge is open to archery deer hunting Sept. 1 - Oct. 31. Landowner permission required.
