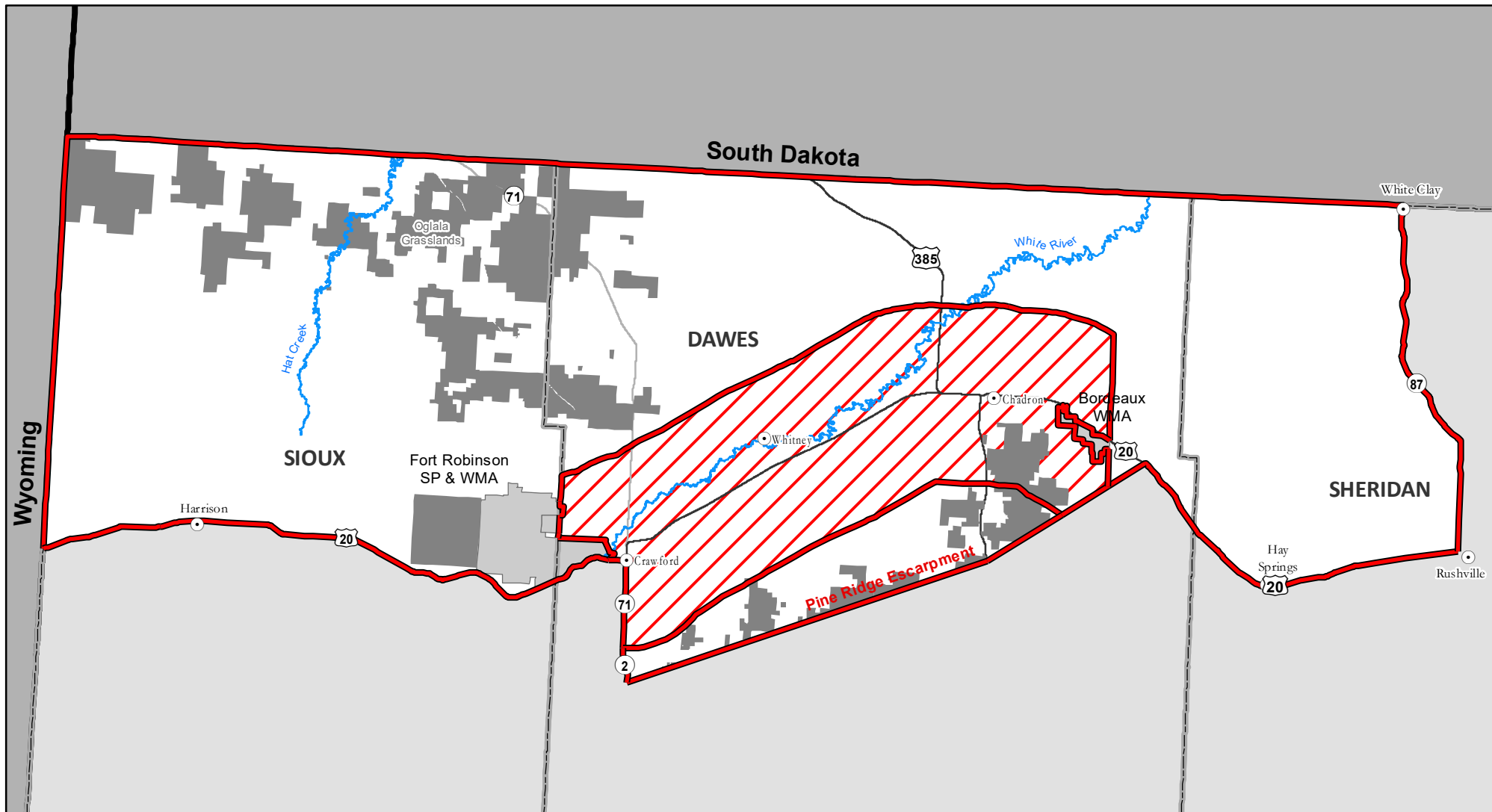


# 2018 North Sioux & North Sioux Late Antelope Units



**MANAGEMENT UNIT DESCRIPTION** - Those parts of Dawes, Sioux and Sheridan counties north and west of a line beginning at the junction of U.S. Hwy. 20 and the Nebraska-Wyoming border, then east on U.S. Hwy. 20 to Neb. Hwy. 2, then south on Neb. Hwy. 2 to the Pine Ridge escarpment, then east along the Pine Ridge escarpment to U.S. Hwy. 20, then east on U.S. Hwy. 20 to Neb. Hwy. 87, then north to the Nebraska-South Dakota border. **NORTH SIOUX LATE**- That portion of the North Sioux Unit within six miles north and south of U.S. Hwy. 20 to the Pine Ridge escarpment, between the Dawes-Sioux county line on the west and the Davenport County Road on the east. Fort Robinson State Park, Fort Robinson Wildlife Management Area, and Bordeaux Creek Wildlife Management Area are excluded from this unit.

**NOTE** - Fort Robinson State Park and Fort Robinson Wildlife Management Area in Sioux and Dawes counties are closed to antelope hunting.
