2020 Application/Purchase Periods

Turkey

Spring – Jan. 13-Season's close – May purchase up to three spring permits.

Fall – Aug. 10-Season's close – May purchase up to two fall permits.

Deer, Pronghorn and Elk

May 18-June 5 – Eligible landowners may apply for one elk permit.

June 8-26 – Residents and nonresidents may apply for one deer draw permit.

Residents and eligible landowners may apply for one buck or either-sex pronghorn permit.

Residents may apply for one elk permit.

July 3 – Results of draw will be available.

July 17 – Last day to complete purchase of awarded draw permit.

Aug. 3-Close of Season – Residents, nonresidents and eligible landowners may purchase remaining deer and pronghorn permits (draw and buy).

Residents and eligible landowners may purchase remaining elk permits (draw).

Bighorn Sheep

April 20-Aug. 7 – Residents may apply for one lottery permit.

Multispecies Lottery Permits

Jan. 2-July 3 – Apply for Super Tag and Combo permits

Applications accepted on first day at 1 p.m. Central Time
