

## LEGAL NOTICE

In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 84-907, public hearings conducted by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, will be held on October 15, 2020 in the Exhibit Hall at Keith County Fairgrounds 100 W 3rd St., Ogallala, NE prior to consideration and/or enactment of the following:

Pursuant to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§37-314, 37-404, 37-414, 37-447, 37-457, 37-502, 37-508, 37-527, 37-534, 37-701, a public hearing will be held at 8:45 a.m. to consider implementation of statutory authority for the creation of new Commission Order C02, Wild Turkey that will contain season dates, permit bag limits, number of permits authorized, shooting hours and areas open.

Pursuant to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 37-314, 37-404, 37-414, 37-447, 37-457, 37-502, 37-508, 37-527, 37-534, 37-701, a public hearing will be held at 9:00 a.m. to consider amendments to Chapter 4, Wildlife Regulations, Section 002, Wild Turkey, regarding the deletion of open seasons, permits authorized, permit bag limits, shooting areas, and areas open which are included in Commission Order C02, Wild Turkey. Section 002 will retain application periods and requirements, youth eligibility, legal weapons, and hunter orange requirements for turkey hunting.

Pursuant to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. 37-301, 37-304, 37-305, 37-308, 37-314, 37-315, 37-344, 37-411, 37-426, 37-4,104, 37-4,107, 37-4,109, 37-4,111, 37-501 through 37-504, 37-508 and 37-543 through 37-545, a public hearing will be held at 9:15 a.m., to consider amendments to Commission Order C06, Sport Fishing, regarding daily bag limits, possession limits, length limits, and open areas.

Copies of the proposed regulations and the Fiscal Impact Statement shall be available for public inspection at the Game and Parks Commission office and the Office of the Secretary of State.

All interested persons may attend and testify orally at the public hearing, but are strongly encouraged to submit written testimony prior to the public hearing in order to protect public health and assist in compliance with restrictions on public gatherings. Interested persons or organizations may submit written comments prior to the hearing, which will be entered into the hearing record if they: 1) include a request to be included as part of the hearing record; 2) include the name and address of the person or organization submitting the comments; and 3) are received by 1:00 p.m. CT, October 13, 2020 by Sheri Henderson at the Lincoln office, 2200 North 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, Lincoln, NE 68503-0370.
