

## 2021 Scholarship Shoot Procedure

- All student-archers eligible to participate in the 2021 Nebraska – NASP – Virtual State Tournament are also eligible to qualify for 2021 Scholarship Shoot.
- All student-archers scoring 274 points or greater, during the Virtual 2021 Nebraska – NASP – State Tournament are invited to follow the Scholarship Shoot Procedure (*outlined below*).
- Scholarship Awards for 2021 Nebraska – NASP – Virtual State Tournament
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Place Female & Male: \$2,000 each
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Female & Male: \$1,000 each
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place Female & Male: \$500 each
- Dates to Shoot for Scholarship: March 8-27, 2021
  - Official Scholarship Scorecards shall be submitted to the address below with a postmark no later than Saturday, March 27, 2021, for inclusion in the 2021 Scholarship Shoot.

- Scholarship Target Face: Only the official 80cm target face provided by the Nebraska Game and Parks are to be used when shooting for score in the 2021 Scholarship Shoot;
  - Scholarship Target Faces shot for score shall be retained by the archer's coach for potential review until April 2, 2021.
- Scholarship Scorecard: Only the official Scholarship Scorecard provided by the Nebraska Game and Parks shall be used for the 2021 Scholarship Shoot.
  - Completed Scholarship Scorecards should be submitted immediately; postmarked no later than the stated deadline of March 27, 2021.
- Official Scholarship Target Faces & Scholarship Scorecards will be made available to coaches after proof of a qualifying score has been provided to [ngpc.NASP@nebraska.gov](mailto:ngpc.NASP@nebraska.gov).
- Format will follow standard NASP procedures; with all arrows shot from the 15-meter shoot line.
- The entire order of shooting for score, once started, shall continue uninterrupted

### Pre Scholarship Shoot

- Any archer shooting a score of 274 or greater during the tournament is invited to participate.
- Archers unable to participate during these dates or not submitting a Scholarship Scorecard by the stated deadline are not be eligible for scholarships.

### Scholarship Shoot Procedure

- The entire order of shooting for score, once started, shall continue uninterrupted
- Archers will shoot six (6) ends of arrows consecutively at 15-meters for score;
  - Each end will include five (5) arrows;
  - One (1) practice end of arrows will be allowed prior to shooting for score;
- Scoring will take place at the end of each end of arrows following standard NASP procedures
  - Section 4: "Scoring" 2021 Nebraska–NASP–Virtual State Tournament Rules & Protocols
- Score for each arrow shall be recorded on the official Scholarship Scorecard.
- Once all six (6) ends of arrows have been shot and scored, the student-archer, range official (BAI) and a witness shall sign the official Scholarship Scorecard in the designated areas.
- Total score from the six (6) ends of arrows will be used to declare 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each gender division.
  - Tie breaker: will be by comparing total score, then # of 10's, 9's, 8's, etc.
