

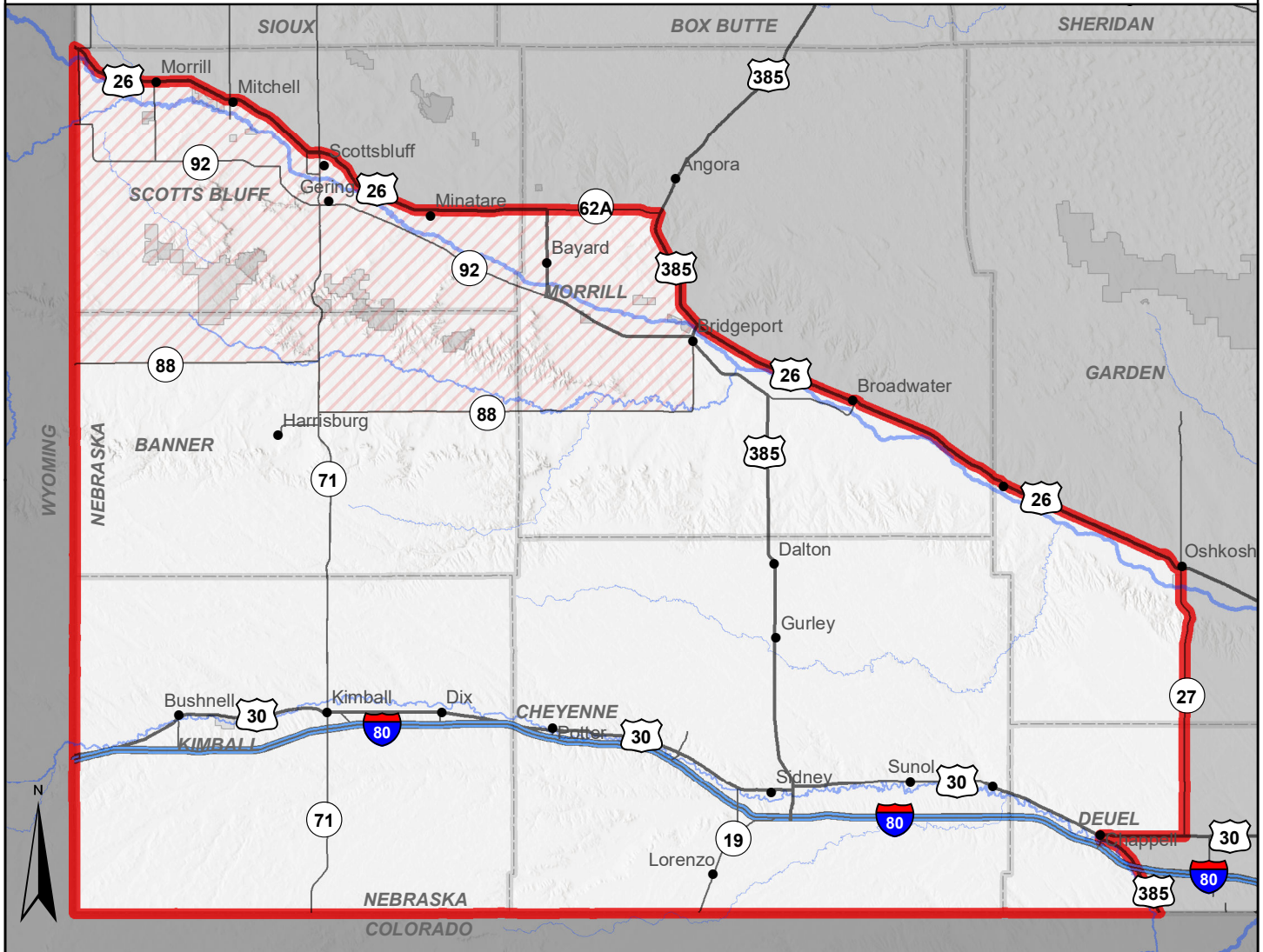

Deer Management Unit Map and Regulations

Bag Limit Exceptions:

- Harvest of antlerless Mule Deer is prohibited on all federal and state-owned lands open to public hunting and The Nature Conservancy, Carter Canyon (PRBE), Montz Point (PRBE) and Bead Mountain (PRBE) areas open to public hunting north of NE Hwy. 88 within the Upper Platte Unit
- See Deer Regulations and the Big Game Guide for additional deer hunting regulations.



Area open:

Upper Platte and AO SCA Upper Platte - Banner, Cheyenne, and Kimball counties and those parts of Deuel, Garden, Morrill, and Scotts Bluff counties south and west of a line commencing at the junction of U.S. Hwy. 26 with the Nebraska-Wyoming state line, thence east on U.S. Hwy. 26 to State Link 62A, thence east on State Link 62A to U.S. Hwy. 385, thence south on U.S. Hwy. 385 to U.S. Hwy. 26, thence east on U.S. Hwy. 26 to NE Hwy. 27, thence south on NE Hwy. 27 to U.S. Hwy. 30, thence west on U.S. Hwy. 30 to U.S. Hwy. 385, thence south on U.S. Hwy. 385 to the Nebraska-Colorado state line.

Landowner permission required to hunt on private land. Public land restrictions may apply, State Parks, USFWS Refuges and other public lands may require access permits or have additional restrictions, contact managing office for details.
