Dear Meat Processor:

This letter is to inform you that the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission is soliciting applications from interested meat processors to participate in the Hunters Helping the Hungry program. This is the third year of the program which pays contracted processors \$85.00 per deer to accept a specific number of whole deer carcasses donated by hunters, process it into pure ground venison, and make it available to a charitable organization specified by the Commission.

This year hunters may offer deer for donation to the program at contracted processors from September 1, 2014 thru January 18, 2015. Processors will process donated deer and arrange for final venison pick up no later than January 31, 2015. The Commission expects to set initial quotas similar to 2013, but to increase those quotas on a contract by contract basis for interested processors when deer donations are within 5 of the initial quota, and as program funds allow.

Only meat processors that are inspected by the USDA or Nebraska Department of Agriculture are eligible to apply. If your facility meets those criteria the Commission invites you to complete and return the enclosed application, along with documentation of your most recent inspection, no later than July 15, 2014.
