


## 2009 Muzzleloader Antelope Units



**MANAGEMENT UNIT DESCRIPTION:** Any person with a permit for the North Sioux Muzzleloader Unit may hunt only in the following described area: Those parts of Dawes, Sioux and Sheridan counties north of U.S. Highway 20 and west of Nebraska Highway 87, and that part of Dawes County south of U.S. Highway 20, east of Nebraska Highway 2, west of U.S. Highway 385, and north of the Pine Ridge escarpment. Persons with Prairie Muzzleloader permits may hunt in all areas of the state except the North Sioux Unit and the Bessey Ranger District of the Nebraska National Forest in Thomas and Blaine counties. **NOTE:** Crescent Lake, Valentine and Fort Niobrara National Wildlife Refuges are not open to antelope hunting.
