In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 84-907, public hearings conducted by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, will be held on March 17, 2021 at Lifelong Learning Center 701 E Benjamin Ave, Norfolk, NE prior to consideration and/or enactment of the following:

Pursuant to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 37-327, 37-405, 37-406, 37-407, 37-409, 37-413, 37-415, 37-416, 37-420, 37-421, 37-421.01, 37-426, 37-427, 37-429, 37-431, 37-438, 37-440, 37-447, 37-449, 37-450, 37-451, 37-455, 37-455.01, 37-457, 37-458, 37-462, 37-465, 37-473, 37-478, 37-479, 37-483, 37-484, 37-491, 37-497, 37-4,104, 37-4,105, 37-4,106, 37-4,108, 37-4,111, 37-1212, 37-1214, 37-1217, 37-1227 a public hearing will be held at 8:30 AM to consider amendments to Administration Regulations, Chapter (1) Section 006, Rules relating to fees for licenses and permits and deployed military permits, The proposed changes include establishing a special season landowner deer permit for both resident and nonresident landowners, establishing the fees for resident and nonresident big game and paddlefish preference/bonus point purchases in lieu of draw; removing the resident aquatic invasive species registration fee and increasing the boat registration fees, and eliminating the duplicate/replacement fee on all permits except deer, antelope, elk, turkey, mountain lion and paddlefish in response to statutory changes associated with the passage of LB's 287 and 126 in 2020.

Pursuant to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 37-314, 37-315, 37-405, 37-411, 37-428, 37-501, 37-508, 37-536, 37-563, 37-701, a public hearing will be held at 8:45 AM to consider amendments to Commission Order C06 Coots, Ducks, Geese, Crow, regarding changes in dates, bag limits, and zone boundaries.

Copies of the proposed regulations and the Fiscal Impact Statement shall be available for public inspection at the Game and Parks Commission office and the Office of the Secretary of State.

Copies of the proposed Commission Order changes shall be available for public inspection at the Game and Parks Commission website at www.outdoornebraska.gov.

All interested persons may attend and testify orally at the public hearing, but are strongly encouraged to submit written testimony prior to the public hearing in order to protect public health and assist in compliance with restrictions on public gatherings. Interested persons or organizations may submit written comments prior to the hearing, which will be entered into the hearing record if they: 1) include a request to be included as part of the hearing record; 2) include the name and address of the person or organization submitting the comments; and 3) are received by 1:00 p.m. CT, March 15, 2021 by Sheri Henderson at the Lincoln office, 2200 North 33rd Street, Lincoln, NE 68503-0370.
