

### Nebraska 2015 Fall Turkey Hunter Survey Results

#### Introduction

At theend of each turkey season, the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission surveys hunters to estimate harvest, effort, and hunter satisfaction. For the Fall 2015 wild turkey season, 9,744 permits were sold, a 4.2% decline from the 10,175 permits sold for the fall 2014 season. Of the permits sold for the 2015 fall season, 1,896 (19.5%) were \$5.00 Youth permits. The remaining 7,848 were regular permits (80.5%). Of the 1,896 permits that were \$5.00 youth permits, 277 were purchased by non-residents and 1,619 were purchased by residents. Of the 7,848 regular permits sold, 794 were purchased by non-residents and 7,054 were purchased by residents.

Permit holders who provided email addresses at the time of purchase were sent an email invitation to participate in the turkey hunter survey on 10 March 2016. Of the 9,744 permits sold, 6,209 (63.7%) were associated with an email address. After accounting for duplicate addresses resulting from hunters purchasing a second fall permit, the final email sample was 5,858, which was 63.4% of unique permit buyers. A total of 275 messages were bounced back to the server as undeliverable, resulting in 5,583 potential respondents. A reminder email was sent to anyone who had not responded to the survey invitation on 17 March 2016, and the survey was closed on 28 March 2016. Additionally, a link to the survey was posted on the NGPC website to allow fall 2015 turkey hunters who did not list an address to participate in the study. This mode of participation was promoted through agency social media accounts, as well as through a press release. The public portal was available to hunters over the same period as the invitation-only version.

At closing, we had recevied 1,228 responses, for raw response rate of 22%. The permit response rate, which takes into account respondents who had purchased a second permit, was 25.5%. Below is a summary of the responses received. Total fall harvest and success rates have been estimated from these data and will be reported separately in the report 2015 Fall Wild Turkey Harvest.

#### **Caveats**

The fall wild turkey hunter survey samples mostly fall turkey hunters who provided valid email addresses, but was available to hunters who did not. However, the majority of responses (1,188) were from the email sample. As such, the sample frame might be biased and not strictly generalizable to the population of all fall turkey hunters. For the fall 2015 season, 63.4% of all unique turkey permit buyers had provided an email address. Further, although a reminder email was sent to non-respondents one week after the initial invitation, no further effort was made to contact hunters who failed to respond, such as follow-up phone interviews, to determine the extent, if any, of non-response bias. The results, therefore, might be biased toward successful hunter, who may more readily respond to harvest related surveys than non-successful hunters. Given that the majority of permit buyers provided an email address, we believe that the chance of bias from this source is low.






"I was satisfied with the number of turkeys I saw."


