Wallus<br/>inensisprairie of the east and the shortgrass prairie<br/>of the west. As a result, the vegetation of this<br/>area varies, with a combination of tallgrass<br/>and shortgrass prairie plants. There are many<br/>wetlands, rivers, and streams. Wooded zones<br/>surround almost every waterway. Precipitation<br/>is greater in the east, with about 28 inches<br/>annually, compared with 20 inches in the west.

The land is primarily used for agriculture, with around two-thirds converted to cropland and much of the remaining third used for grazing livestock. There is however, a diversity of wildlife found in this region, including the annual spring staging of 500,000 sandhill cranes around the Platte River in central Nebraska. This spectacle draws around 80,000 nature enthusiasts each year, with about half from outside of Nebraska.

# **Gray Hairstreak** Strvmon melinus

Size: WS: 1.0 - 1.25 in. **Description:** Upperside of wings dark, underside gray with white edging, orange patch with black spot above wing-tails. Diet: Fruit (larva), nectar (adult) Habitat: Open fields Viewing: Spring-fall, statewide



#### White-lined Sphinx Moth Hvles lineta Size: WS: 2.4 - 3.6 in. **Description:** Striped olive-brown

with horizontal light tan stripe on forewing, and thicker horizontal pink stripe on hind wing. Diet: Nectar Habitat: Rural to urban Viewing: Spring-summer, statewide







# Chrvsochus auratus Size: L: 0.31 - 0.43 in. coloration.

Colias philodice Size: WS: 1.5 - 2.75 in. **Description:** Male: Yellow-green with dark edging on wings, white evespot on underwing, Female: yellow-white, less bold edging. Diet: Nectar Habitat: Open fields Viewing: Summer, statewide



## **Big Sand Tiger Beetle** Cicindela formosa

Size: L: 0.59 - 0.8 in. Description: Red-purple with white markings and spindly legs. Diet: Insects Habitat: Sand blowouts, dunes and stream banks Viewing: Summer, mostly statewide, excluding southern Panhandle and southeast corner



### **Spotted Lady Beetle** Coleomegilla maculata Size: L: 0.2 - 0.23 in. **Description:** Oval-shaped, red to pink beetle with irregular black spots. **Diet:** Aphids, mites and pollen Habitat: Crop fields and gardens Viewing: Summer, east



# **Diet:** Nectar and pollen Habitat: Fields - agriculture Viewing: Summer, Panhandle
