- Hunters will be randomly assigned to parks/timeframes/zones/tree stands based on preferences provided.
- Successful applicants and interested alternates must attend an orientation at Schramm State Park on Nov. 21st for archers and on Dec. 13th for muzzloaders beginning at 7:00 PM
- Statewide Archery, Wahoo Antlerless Only Season Choice and/or Youth Deer permits are required
- A Park Entry Pass is required to enter the Parks
- *Two-person tree stands have a 500 lb. weight limit
