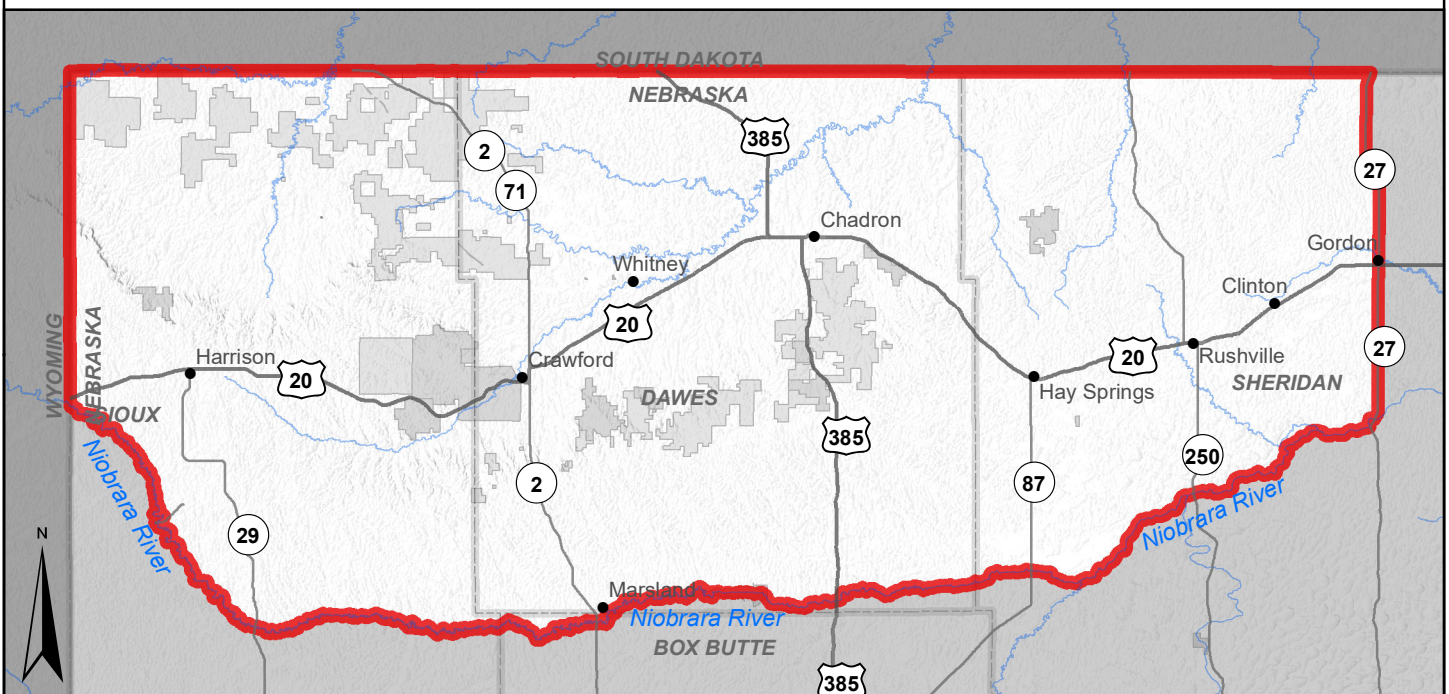

Deer Management Unit Map and Special Regulations

- The Pine Ridge Unit is a Mule Deer Conservation Area (MDCA) unit:
 - Statewide Muzzleloader, Restricted Statewide Buck and Nonresident Statewide Archery Permits are not valid for Mule Deer in the MDCA.
- Harvest of antlerless mule deer is prohibited on lands open to public hunting; lands enrolled in the Open Fields and Waters program are exempt from this restriction. This only applies to permits that allow antlerless mule deer harvest. Bag limits that prohibit antlerless mule deer cannot take an antlerless mule deer anywhere.
- Private Land Only Pine Ridge permit is not valid on any land open to public hunting access.

Area open:

Pine Ridge and AO SCA Pine Ridge - Those parts of Box Butte, Dawes, Sheridan, and Sioux counties north of the Niobrara River and west of NE Hwy. 27. Private Land Only Pine Ridge permit is not valid on any land open to public hunting access.

Landowner permission required to hunt on private land. Public land restrictions may apply, State Parks, USFWS Refuges and other public lands may require access permits or have additional restrictions, contact managing office or the Public Access Atlas for details.
