

Official rules of the Your Parks Adventure challenge

The Nebraska Game and Parks Commission is challenging outdoor enthusiasts to explore the diverse trails of the state of Nebraska by participating in Your Parks Adventure: Trail Trek.

Participants who visit any of the listed trails, snap a picture at one of our designated Trail Trek signs, and submit it online are eligible for a chance to win prizes. Pictures must be from a designated Trail Trek sign; 47 signs are located across the state. Most Trail Trek locations are within a half mile of trailheads.

Official rules

- 1. The promotion begins May 22, 2024, and ends Oct. 31, 2024. All submissions must take place during the contest period to be eligible to win.
- 2. Participants must be 19 years or older to be eligible for the grand prize.
- 3. Participants must register for the contest online at YourParksAdventure.com. participants will use their log-in to submit each of their trail entries, which can be uploaded after each trail visit or all at once.
- 4. Submissions must include:
 - a. First and last name
 - b. A valid address
 - c. A valid email address
 - d. A valid phone number
 - e. Trail location and date visited.
 - f. A photo or "selfie" with the Trail Trek sign from each trail location. Trail name on Trail Trek sign must be visible in photo to receive credit.
 - g. A description of your visit to the trail or your "Trail Trek."
 - h. All photos will become property of the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission. Any photos, names or information submitted can be shared in promotional materials including social media or used to promote the Your Parks Adventure challenge or Nebraska state parks. This does not apply to registered accounts for participants who are 18 years of age and under.

- 5. Multiple entries for the same trail trek sign count as one.
- 6. Prize Tiers are as follows:
 - a. Level 1 (1 Entry): With one entry, you are eligible to receive a prize or token available for pickup at designated park locations. Entitles you to one entry into the prize drawing.
 - b. Level 2 (10 19 Entries): Foldable Water Bottle: For accumulating 10 to 19 entries, you are eligible to receive a foldable water bottle. Prize will be mailed at the conclusion of the contest period. You will receive an equivalent number of entries into the prize drawing.
 - c. Level 3 (20 39 Entries): Commemorative Walking Stick Medallion: Upon reaching 20 to 39 entries, you are eligible to receive a commemorative walking stick medallion. Prize will be mailed at the conclusion of the contest period. You will receive an equivalent number of entries into the grand prize drawing.
 - d. Level 4 (40+ Entries): Commemorative T-shirt: Achieving 40 or more entries qualifies you to receive a commemorative Trail Trek T-shirt. T-shirt will be mailed at the conclusion of the contest period. You will receive an equivalent number of entries into the prize drawing.
 - e. Prize Drawing: Prizes include outdoor gear, Nebraskaland Magazine subscriptions*, and Nebraskaland calendars.
 - f. Grand Prize: Two-night cabin stay at a Nebraska state park, outdoor gear, Magazine subscription, and calendar.
- 7. At the conclusion of the contest period, the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission will randomly draw prize winners from the list of all eligible submissions made between May 22, 2024, and Oct. 31, 2024. Winners will be notified by email, telephone, or mail within two weeks of the conclusion of the contest period.
- 8. Prizes won in this program may not be returned to the providing retailer or organization for cash or credit.
- 9. Employees of the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission are not eligible to win prizes.
