

In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 84-907, a public hearing will be conducted by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission on June 21, 2024, in the meeting room of the Petrified Wood Gallery 418 E 1st St. Ogallala, NE prior to consideration and/or enactment of the following:

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 37-301, 37-304, 37-305, 37-308, 37-314, 37-315, 37-344, 37-411, 37-426, 37-4,104, 37-4,107, 37-4,109, 37-4,111, 37-501 through 37-504, 37-508 and 37-543 through 37-545, a public hearing will be held at 8:15 AM to consider amendments to Title 163 Chapter 2 Fisheries Regulations Section 006 Sport Fishing relating to the use of live bait fish and special area regulations.

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 37-301, 37-304, 37-308, 37-308.01, 37-314, 37-228, 37-404, 37-405, 37-411, 37-426, 37-452, 37-473, 37-613, a public hearing will be held at 8:30 AM to consider amendments to Title 163 Chapter 4, Wildlife Regulations, Section 037, Mountain Lions to add areas open to harvest, and harvest limits.

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ Sections 37-301 through 37-313, 37-337 through 37-352, 37-434 through 37-446, 37-1001 through 37-1015,37-1264 and 37-1266, 60-314 and 60-3,105, 60-680, 60-6,190,60-6,334, and 60-6,353 through 60-6,362 a public hearing will be held at 8:45 AM to consider amendments to Title 163 Chapter 6, Park Regulations Section 001 General Regulations Governing the Administration and Use of State Park Property relating to the issuance of Active -duty Military Park Permits, update the replacement process for Nebraska Resident Disabled American Veteran's Permit; clarify and update regulations for designated state recreational trails and clarify boundary processes and right of way leases. Changes also include language for the use and regulation of e-bikes on state park properties.

Copies of the proposed regulations and the Fiscal Impact Statement shall be available for public inspection at the Game and Parks Commission office and on-line at the Office of the Secretary of State's website.

All interested persons may attend and testify orally or by written submission at the public hearing.
