

In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 84-907, public hearings will be conducted by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission on August 16, 2024, in the Buffalo Barracks at Fort Robinson State Park 3200 Highway 20 Crawford, NE prior to consideration and/or enactment of the following:

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ Sections 37-301 through 37-313, 37-337 through 37-352, 37-434 through 37-446, 37-1001 through 37-1015, 37-1264 and 37-1266, 60-314 and 60-3, 105, 60-680, 60-6,190, 60-6,334, and 60-6, 353 through 60-6,362, a public hearing will be held at 8:15 AM to consider amendments to Title 163 Chapter 5, Park Regulations, Section 001, General Regulations governing the administration and use of state park property to update language regarding where snowmobiles and all-terrain and motorized off-highway amphibious vehicles can be operated on frozen lake surfaces.

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 37-301, 37-303, 37-314, 37-308, 37-308.01, 37-317, 37-404, 37-426, 37-427, 37-451, 37-452, 37-505, a public hearing will be held at 8:30 AM to consider amendments to Wildlife Commission Order C014, Mountain Sheep regarding the authorization of mountain sheep hunting permits for the 2025 season.

All interested persons may attend and testify orally or by written submission at the public hearing. Interested persons or organizations may submit written comments prior to the hearing, which will be entered into the hearing record if they: 1) include a request to be included as part of the hearing record; 2) include the name and address of the person or organization submitting the comments; and 3) are received by 1:00 p.m. CT August 14, 2024 by Sheri Henderson at the Lincoln office, 2200 North 33rd Street, Lincoln, NE 68503-0370.
