A Nebraska Resident Veteran Small Game Hunt/Fish/Fur Harvest permit, when issued to a qualifying veteran, is valid to hunt small game and waterfowl, fish and fur harvest and includes a state aquatic, habitat, and waterfowl stamp. A Federal Duck Stamp and HIP number are required to hunt Migratory waterfowl.

When applying for a 64 & Older Resident Veteran Annual Small Game Hunt/Fish/Fur Harvest Permit, application can also be made in person at our commission offices, service centers or park locations with the required documentation (DD214 or Veteran indicator on a Nebraska Driver's license). Annual renewals can be purchased online, at vendor locations and commission offices. See **OutdoorNebraska.gov** for more details, search keyword "Veteran".

Nebraska residency must be retained for the permit to remain valid, permit expires on December 31st of each calendar year and is to be renewed annually.
