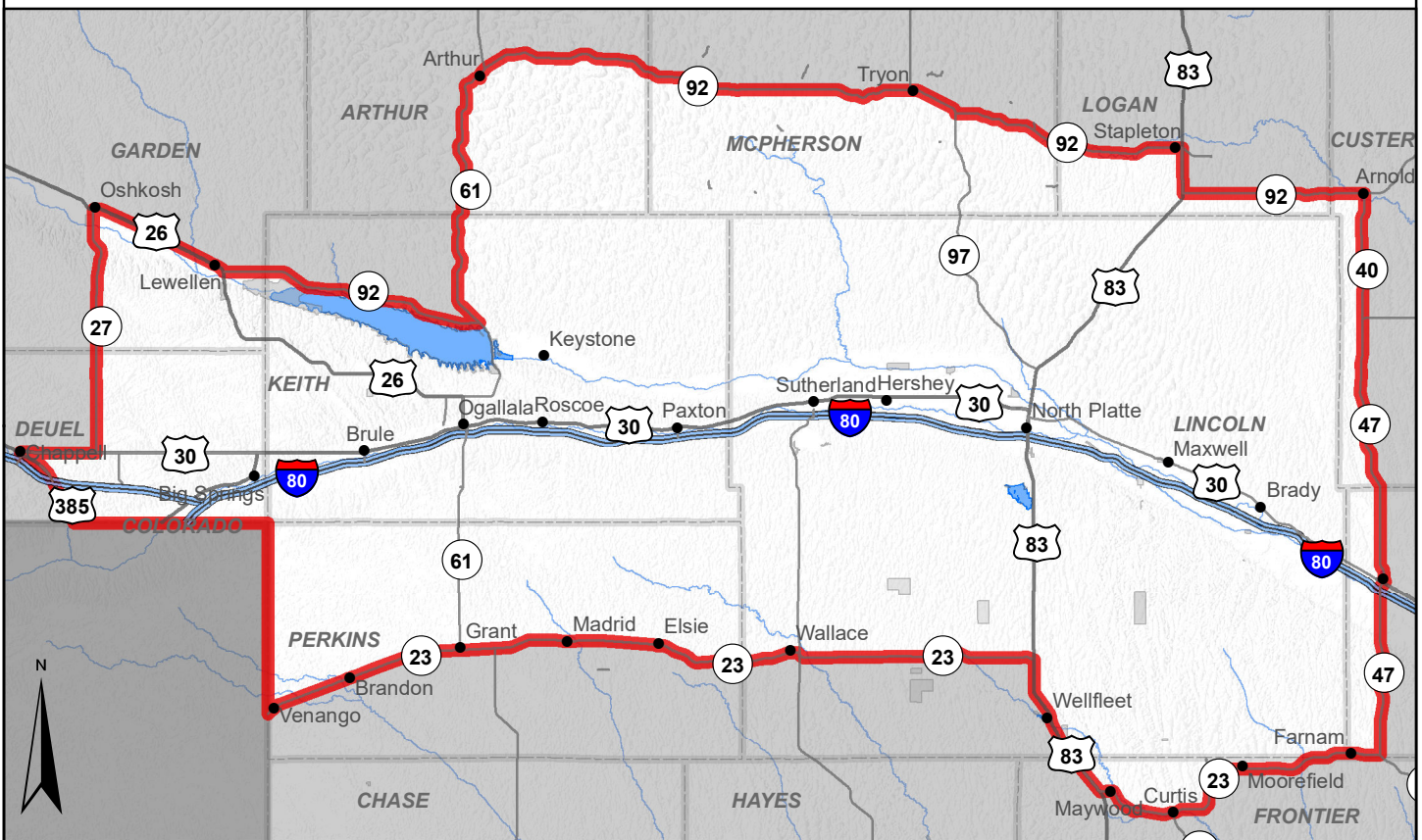

Deer Management Unit Map and Special Regulations



- The Platte Unit is a Mule Deer Conservation Area (MDCA) unit:
 - Statewide Muzzleloader, Restricted Statewide Buck and Nonresident Statewide Archery Permits are not valid for Mule Deer in the MDCA.
- Harvest of antlerless mule deer is prohibited on lands open to public hunting; lands enrolled in the Open Fields and Waters program are exempt from this restriction. This only applies to permits that allow antlerless mule deer harvest. Bag limits that prohibit antlerless mule deer cannot take an antlerless mule deer anywhere.

Area open:

Platte and AO SCA Platte - Those parts of Arthur, Custer, Dawson, Deuel, Frontier, Garden, Keith, Lincoln, Logan, McPherson, and Perkins counties south of NE Hwy. 92, west of NE Hwys. 40 and 47, north of NE Hwy. 23, and east of a line commencing at the junction of NE Hwy. 27 and NE Hwy. 92, thence south on NE Hwy. 27 to U.S. Hwy. 30, thence west on U.S. Hwy. 30 to U.S. Hwy. 385, thence south on U.S. Hwy. 385 to the Nebraska- Colorado state line.

Landowner permission required to hunt on private land. Public land restrictions may apply, State Parks, USFWS Refuges and other public lands may require access permits or have additional restrictions, contact managing office or see the Public Access Atlas for details.
