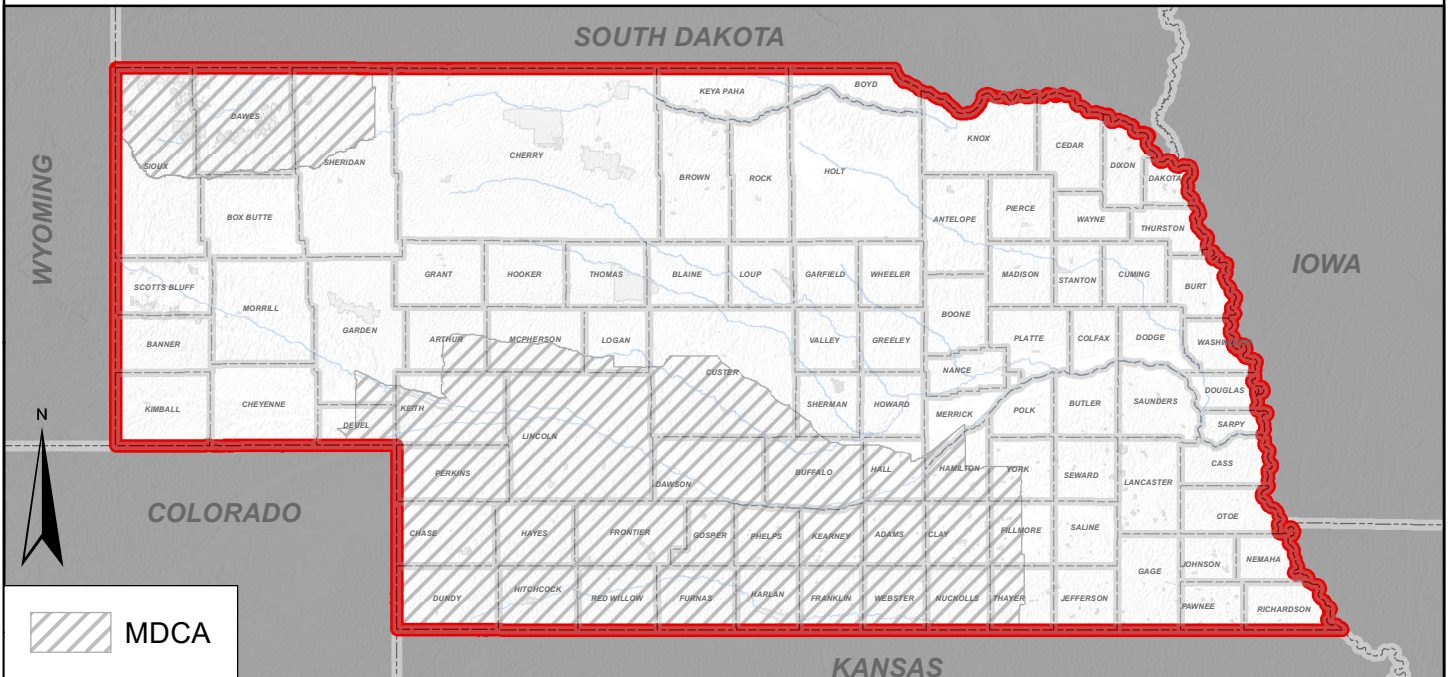

Deer Permit Map and Special Regulations



- Nonresident Archery: Mule deer may not be taken in the Mule Deer Conservation Area (MDCA).
- Harvest of antlerless mule deer is prohibited on lands open to public hunting; lands enrolled in the Open Fields and Waters program are exempt from this restriction. This only applies to permits that allow antlerless mule deer harvest. Bag limits that prohibit antlerless mule deer cannot take an antlerless mule deer anywhere.

Area open:

Statewide Archery - Entire State except Federal or State sanctuaries and refuges, unless otherwise authorized.

Landowner permission required to hunt on private land. Public land restrictions may apply. State Parks, USFWS Refuges and other public lands may require access permits or have additional restrictions; contact managing agency office or see the Public Access Atlas for details.
