Title of Job: 2011 Prairie Grouse Cooperator Survey

We received 105 envelopes containing 222 grouse wings from 62 cooperating hunters and East Zone permit holders in 2011. Participating hunters reported harvesting 289 grouse during the 2011-12 season (1 September-31 January), for an average of 1.21 grouse harvested/hunter-day. The statewide sample contained 76 sharp-tailed grouse wings (71.1% juveniles) and 146 greater prairie-chicken wings (56.8% juveniles). Statewide there were 2.46 juveniles/adult sharptails and 1.32 juveniles/adult prairie chickens.

We 45 envelopes containing 143 wings from 16 West zone cooperating hunter. Of the wings returned, 76 were sharp-tailed grouse (71.1% juveniles/ 2.46 juveniles/adult) and 67 were greater prairie-chicken (52.2% juveniles; 1.09 juveniles/adult). From the East zone, we received 60 envelopes containing 79 wings from 46 East zone permit holders (60.8% juveniles; 1.55 juveniles/adult).
