


Figure 1. Monthly distribution of grouse harvest during the 2023-24 season.

2023-24 Grouse Hunter Cooperator Survey—During the 2023-24 season, 319 wing envelopes were turned between the west (306) and east (13) grouse zones, containing 597 wings. In the west zone, of the 379 sharp-tail wings, 59% were juvenile, whereas 56% of the 180 prairie-chicken wings were juvenile. Overall hunting success was 0.94 grouse per hunter-day, which was higher than in 2022-23, 0.86 grouse per hunter-day (Table 1). In the east zone no sharp-tail grouse were harvested. There were 19 prairie-chicken wings, 37% were juveniles. Hunter success was 1.06 grouse per hunter-day, which was down from 2022-23, 1.23 grouse per hunter-day (Table 2). Harvest in both zones primarily occurred during September and October and declined monthly thereafter (Figure 1).



Production indices for Prairie Grouse 1996-2023




Figure 2. Production indices for prairie grouse harvested by hunter-cooperators in the Grouse Hunter Cooperator Survey, 1996-2023 (East and West Zones combined).
