Stat. §§ 37-301, 37-304, 37-308, 37-308.01, 37-314, 37-228, 37-404, 37-405, 37-411, 37-426, 37-452, 37-473, 37-613, a public hearing will be held at 8:15 AM to consider amendments to Title 166 Chapter 20 Mountain Lions to clarify unit boundaries and adjust harvest limits in the Niobrara Management Unit.
